## THE GARDENS AT PRAIRIESTAR

## **2024 DISTRICT MEETINGS**

The Board of Directors ("Board") regular meetings are scheduled for: June 19, September 18, and November 20, at 5:00 p.m. via Zoom. Agendas and Zoom information will be posted to the District's website no later than 24 hours in advance of each meeting.

There are 4 types of meetings held by the District Board:

- ♦ Regular Meetings: These are meetings are where the regular business of the District is discussed and voted on.
- Special Meetings: These meetings are called for special purposes when the Board needs to discuss and take action in between regular meetings or if a regular meeting is rescheduled.
- Work Sessions: These are for the Board to meet in a public forum and discuss District business, but no formal action is taken by the Board at work sessions.
- Annual Meeting: This is an annual meeting required by statute for the District to report to the public on any infrastructure projects, outstanding debt, and current year financial status. No action is taken by the Board at the annual meeting.
- \* All District meetings are subject to Colorado Open Meeting Laws.
